<u>NEW this semester:</u> Intervention assignments, because they are not supervised,
cannot be used as a substitute for the standardized PAAE exam.

Remember that an Intervention Assignment is just to provide the student with additional practice for the standardized exam. As an incentive, remind the student that the higher intervention score will boost his or her overall course average.

- A student who obtains a passing score of 70% or higher on the PAAE is eligible for an upgrade to MAT 51 regardless of course performance and/or attendance history.
- A student who fails the PAAE, but satisfies all course requirements outlined in the syllabus and passes the CUNY Exam, is eligible for an S grade.(A CUNY Central decision)
- A student who passes the CUNY Exam, but does not satisfies all course requirements outlined in the syllabus, may <u>not</u> be eligible for an S grade.**
- **May be a candidate for Project Advance, Immersion or another Intervention offered by the Department of Mathematics.
 - Instructors must post PAAE scores on the MyMathLab grade book.
