

POLICY FOR CEAFE TESTING: MAT 12, MAT 51, MAT 56. 5

The CUNY Elementary Algebra Final Examination (CEAFE) Exam will be given to students on the day and time that their class is tested. Under no circumstances will a student be permitted to take the CEAFE before the class is tested during final exam week.

Students who miss the CEAFE exam because of illness or an emergency can visit the math department (at the end of the semester, after the date of the missed exam) for permission to re-test. They may be asked for proof explaining why they could not take the exam on the scheduled date, such as a physician's note.

MAT 56.5 students are given two opportunities to take the CEAFE with their class. A student in MAT 56.5 who misses the first CEAFE date (given mid semester) for any reason can take the exam with his or her class during finals week, but not before.

In order to be fair to everyone, there will be no exceptions to this policy.
